

Nordic Dairy Congress

Dairy organizations from Iceland, Finland, Sweden, Norway and Denmark have during the last century collaborated in organizing the Nordic Dairy Congresses.

Nowadays this collaboration is formalised in the Nordic Dairy Technology Council. Since 2018 the Society of Dairy Technology from the UK has been involved with the Council.

'Nordic Dairy Congress' has been a recurrent event for one hundred years. The congress in 2022 will be the 45th Nordic Dairy Congress and the congress venue will be The Clarion Hotel Malmö Live.

At the end of the congress the 100-years anniversary will be celebrated in the banquet hall, Knutssalen in the old City Hall of Malmö where the municipality and the Mayor of Malmö will host the Gala Dinner.
